<u>Stipendienlotse</u>: This is the database of the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF). It also lists doctoral scholarships offered by companies such as Airbus, Bayer and Novartis. Only available in German.

Mystipendium offers a detailed database allowing you to search for specific scholarships that might not be found otherwise. The site also offers vacancies, guides and resources on how to apply. Only available in German, a registration is necessary.
